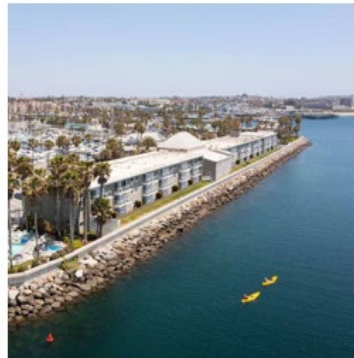
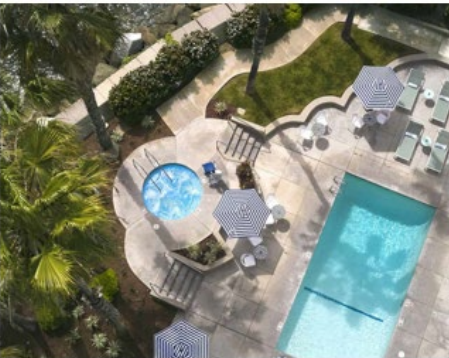
### THE PORTOFINO HOTEL & MARINA
